Hon'ble Governor of Odisha, Dr. S. C. Jamir was sworn in on 21st March, 2013 in the Abhishek Hall of Raj Bhavan. Dr. Jamir was one of the signatories to the historic Agreement which is popularly known as the 16 Point Agreement with the Government of India in 1960 that resulted in the creation of the State of Nagaland as the sixteenth State of the Indian Union.

He was appointed as Parliamentary Secretary to the First Prime Minister of India, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru in 1962. Later he served as Union Deputy Minister of Railways, Labour and Employment, Community Development, Cooperation, Food and Agriculture between 1966 and 1970 during the Prime Ministership of Mrs. Indira Gandhi.

He was a member of the Indian Delegation to UNO in 1962 as Political Advisor. He was also a member of the Indian delegation to International Labour Organization (ILO) at Geneva in 1968. He was the Deputy leader of the Indian delegation to International Social Welfare Conference at Manila in 1969.

In recognition of his distinguished public service Dr. Jamir was conferred with several awards prestigious such as Rashtriya Ekta Puraskar by the Committee for National Integration, National Citizen Award, "Arch of Asia" at Bangkok, Distinguished Leadership Award titled Man of the Year 1998 by the American Biographical Institute, USA. He was conferred Doctorate of Divinity (Honoris Causa) by the University of Serampore, West Bengal, Doctor of Literature (Honoris Causa) by Nagaland University, Hanseo University, Seoul, South Korea and Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University, Rajasthan.

SO FAR

A COMPETITIVE MOTIVATION

The journey of CPS started with 4 students only and without any promotional activity or marketing strategy, we have enrolled more than 100 students in our school and these numbers are growing day by day, which makes us feel proud of.

What CPS looks today is just the tip of the iceberg. We have come to know that some well reputed schools have started a new marketing strategy by going door to door promoting their respective schools and highlighting features like 'no admission fee', 'no photograph required', 'no blood group needed' and luring the parents to get their kids admitted immediately. Some say they have started worrying about their business loss because of growing reputation of CPS. We do not take these statements seriously what others are doing, we are confident and believe, if our foundation is strong we will grow step by step and don't require these kind of marketing strategies.

The truth is we walk on a path of integrity, honesty and deliver what we promise. Parents falling for these cheap tricks should realize why reputed schools are sending promoters to their door steps, ignoring the basic criteria of student's admission and making it sound like an extraordinary feature.

We have admitted students that were rejected by other schools, rejected because one was deaf & dumb, one was adopted from an orphanage and lacked manners, and many others kids following a similar scenario. Today we are proud to say that these rejects have become the jewels of CPS. Their talent surpasses most of the students in the school and their parents are more than happy to see the miracle that transformed their child into a better human being.

QUALITY OF EDUCATION

Our goal at CPS has always been to provide quality education from the very beginning of a child's schooling career, by education it doesn't mean books and notes, but a way in which students love to learn and remember the basics for a lifetime.

By using practical methods & real life examples and applying funny & innovative ways to create an event in the child's brain cell, helping them better understand and recall the topic whenever and wherever needed.

At the young age a child learns and remembers the things very quickly because the brain is at its best state of recording data. They are explorers and we allow them to explore and learn new things by taking them to frequent trips and tours.

We conduct regular speech programmes where young students are given the stage to speak on a topic provided, thus, building confidence and overcoming stage fear from a very young age.

They know that the teacher is able to see them from the camera walking in from the main gate, so to hide themselves, they started to crawl in like little soldiers unaware of the fact that we could still see them clearly.

Most of the parents request us not to declare holidays, even the major ones, the reason being that their kid(s) cry at home, because they want to go to the school; wow, we never saw this one coming...

STORY UNHEARD UNSAID...

God created us human beings considering the fact of physical and mental equality, yet there are certain amongst us with greater abilities that outperform the majority of us despite the fact that they are either physically or mentally challenged. To name a few with such abilities were Einstein, Newton, Beethoven, Edison, etc. We know them as history's greatest individuals that were second to none. But the real fact is that they had to go through a lot of hardship and challenges in their childhood life.

Einstein, the genius was considered as a retard by his parents and teachers when he was a child. His grades in school were consistently poor and he couldn't even read till the age of seven. No one could have predicted the child would go on to win the Nobel prizes in physics.

Thomas had a mental illness considered Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder. He was a hyperactive child, prone to distraction and was considered "difficult" by his teachers. But that didn't stop him to hold more than 1,000 patents for his inventions including the light bulb, alkaline storage battery, phonograph, etc. and being the founder of General Electric.

Beethoven was incredibly awkward on the violin but loved to compose music, his teachers felt he was hopeless at it and would never succeed with the violin or in composing. Beethoven kept persisting along and composed, as we know, some of the best-loved symphonies of all time – five of them at an age when he was completely deaf!

Newton, one of the greatest scientists of all time, suffered from bipolar disorder combined with psychotic tendencies and autism spectrum. He also had a brain disorder in which he would interpret reality abnormally. Whether he suffered from one or a combination of these serious illnesses, it did not stop him from inventing calculus, explaining gravity, and building telescopes, among his other great scientific achievements.

At CPS, we have accommodated a student that was rejected by various other schools for the fact that he was deaf and dumb. We remembered the famous quote from Pablo Picasso, the world-famous artist who said "Every child is an artist. The problem is how to remain an artist once we grow up" and allotted him to our school.

We were simply astounded to find out that the kid was a God gifted artist, the above picture of Lord Ganesha was hand drawn by the student with his imagination during a drawing competition. It makes us feel proud to have such a gifted boy as our student, yet we don't make him feel any different from the other students, because for us all the students are equal. Moreover, the interesting fact is that the other students are unaware of the fact of his disability and treat him equally as their friend.



There is yet another student who was adopted by a parent. The child had no manners, literally, and his behavior towards others was animal-like. His parents were upset about his behavior and was rejected by many schools. He didn't even know how to use a spoon or how to talk to others and used to snatch other students' foods & belongings and even latch the door of faculty room and bathrooms while someone was inside.

Till date he was the most difficult student to handle, but we didn't give up on him. With time, countless unconditional hours of efforts and special care, today that same kid has efficiently learned the basic ethics of life. He is now friendly with everyone, obeys the teachers and does the task in hand with great patience. This is what we call "The Magic of CPS."

IT'S MORE THAN ART &

The motions involved in making art, such as holding a paintbrush or scribbling with a crayon, are essential for the growth of fine motor skills in young children.

As per the guidelines of National Institutes of Health, we emphasize the use of brushes, crayons and scissors because it develops the dexterity children will need for writing.

Crafting helps children develop eye-hand coordination. As children decide how to make parts fit together into a whole, where to place objects, and what details to include, they learn to coordinate what they see with the movements of their hands and fingers.

This eye-hand coordination is essential for many activities, including forming letters, spacing words while writing and performing tasks without needing to stop first and think. Thus, improving this skill increases child's overall efficiency.

When kids are encouraged to express themselves, and take risks in creating art, they develop a sense of innovation that will be important in their adult lives as well.

For young children, making art provides them the opportunities to learn words for colours, shapes and actions. Art also builds children's confidence by giving them opportunities to express what they are thinking and feeling.

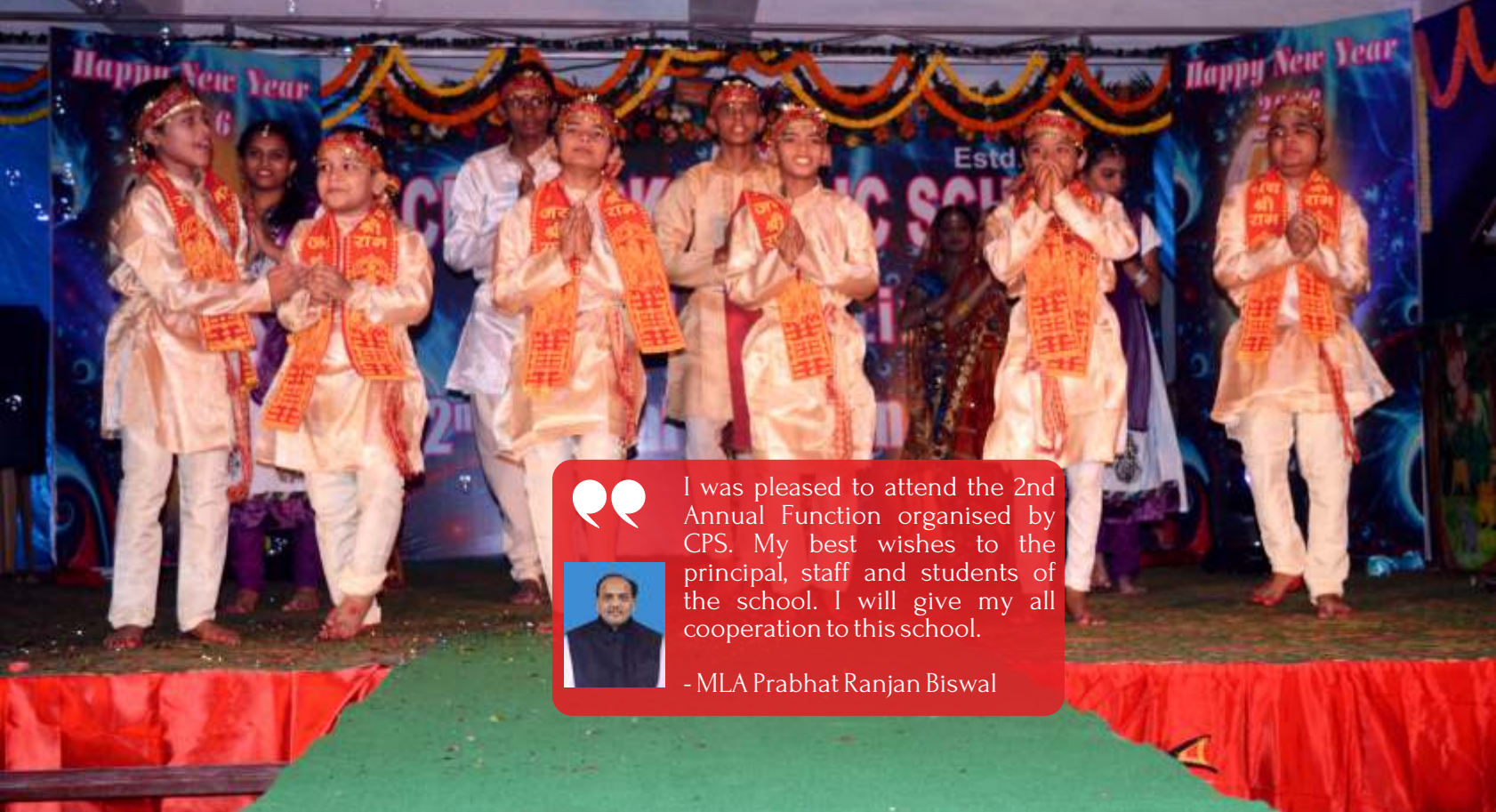

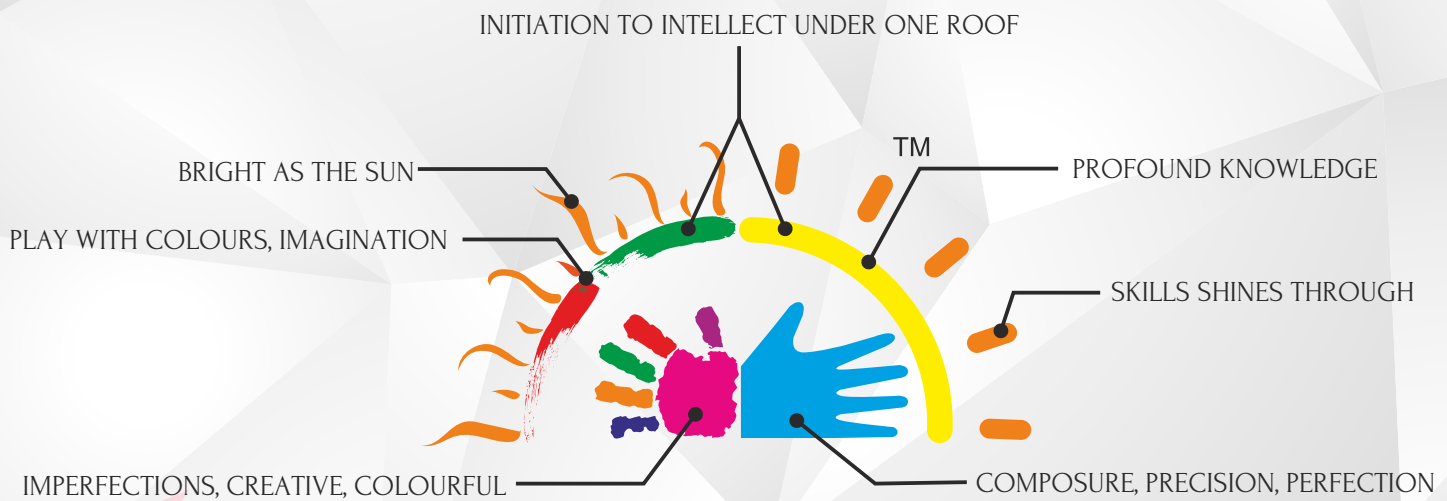
MORE THAN ECO-FRIENDLY
